

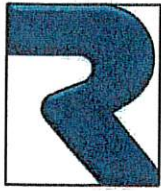

The City of Rockford's Wastewater Treatment Facility is ageing and needs improvements. Many key components of the facility are past their recommended service life and are starting to fail. These improvements are necessary to increase workplace safety for staff, reduce the cost of operation, and allow the City to continue to properly treat its wastewater which maintains the integrity of the local environmental resources.

The WWTF Improvements project will address several needs which include constructing a new influent screen for preliminary treatment, upgrades to the WWTF controls system, replacing aeration basin fine bubble diffusers, and refurbishing the final clarifier mechanisms. Investing in this key public infrastructure will allow Rockford to continue their effective wastewater treatment well into the future while not pulling limited staff resources away from maintaining the rest of the critical infrastructure in the community.

The City of Rockford appreciates consideration for assistance through the Federal Community Project Funding. These funds will allow the City to complete the improvements without creating a substantial burden on the City taxpayers.
