**A BILL**

To provide enhanced security at Armed Forces recruitment centers through the installation of reinforced bullet-proof glass and entry doors.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INSTALLATION OF REINFORCED BULLET**  
4 **PROOF GLASS AND ENTRY DOORS AT ARMED**  
5 **FORCES RECRUITMENT CENTERS.**

6 The Secretary of each of the military departments,  
7 and the Secretary of the Department in which the Coast  
8 Guard is operating, shall provide for the installation of  
9 reinforced bullet-proof glass and entry doors at Armed  
10 Forces recruitment centers, including facilities leased for

1 use as recruitment centers, under the jurisdiction of the  
2 Secretary as an additional security measure to protect  
3 members of the Armed Forces serving as recruiters and  
4 potential recruits and other individuals visiting recruit-  
5 ment centers.
