Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the City of Sartell's Force Main Project in fiscal year 2026. The intended recipient is the City of Sartell located at 125 Pinecone Road North Sartell, MN 56377. The project would be a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the City of Sartell's current infrastructure consists of only one force main for sanitary sewer, which brings all biproducts to the City of St. Cloud for treatment. This force main has only 400,000 gallons per day in available capacity. With additional development taking place in Sartell which will impact pressure on this system, there will no longer be capacity remaining for development or community growth.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
