I am requesting funding for the CSAH 19 and CSAH 18 Intersection Improvements Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Wright County, located at 3600 Braddock Avenue NE, Buffalo, MN, 55313. The funding would be used for the intersection of County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 19/Labeaux Ave NE and CSAH 18/Jason Ave NE/50th St NE in Albertville. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because reconstructing the intersection addresses deficiencies and aligns with significant investments already made on CSAH 19 north and south of the intersection in Hanover, St. Michael, and Albertville to improve mobility and accessibility to I-94, a major economic corridor for communities within Wright County.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
