The Stearns County Parks Commission and the Stearns County Parks Department are writing to express our support for the Heatherwood Road Extension Project.

The Heatherwood Road Extension project includes critical community connections of road, trail (alternative transportation and recreational), utilities, and bridge elements. The completion of this project will not only have a significant local impact, but a regional and national impact as well. The completion of this project will bring trail users (local, regional Beaver Island Trail and the National Mississippi River Trail) off busy roads onto a separated trail designated for non-motorized use.

Stearns County recently completed construction of a 3.5-mile section of the Beaver Island non-motorized, alternative transportation and recreational trail; and the City of St. Cloud recently constructed trail from the Anderson Trucking Maintenance Facility to the intersection of 8th Avenue South and 60th Street South. However, there is still a gap between the existing city's portions of the Beaver Island Trail (McStop area to Opportunity Drive).
